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LAW LIBRARY. The Furman Smith Law Library has a staff of fifteen, including five professional librarians. The librarians provide extensive instruction in both print and electronic research as part of the curriculum. The library's collection includes over 350,000 volumes in books and microforms as well as a wide array of legal and non-legal electronic resources. Carrels, tables, soft seating, "smart" study rooms and a technology lounge are available to law students. Throughout the library and law school, students have wireless access to the library and law school network via their personal laptops.
